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Dear Academy Days Visitor:

Academy Days is scheduled for **Sunday and Monday, April 22 and 23, 2018**. These two days with us are a great opportunity for 8th graders and academy-aged students to visit classes, stay a night in the dorm, eat "cafe" food, tour the campus, make some new friends and just "get a feel" for academy life! *(Since the time is planned to introduce new students to GLAA, former GLAA students are requested to check with an administrator prior to coming to campus.)*

All visiting students are asked to arrive on campus at our Administration Building on **Sunday, April 22, between 1:00-2:30pm** for registration. This is also a great opportunity to meet up with other arriving guests and to mingle with current GLAA students. Accompanying parents/sponsors can plan on using their time to help students they brought fill out paperwork, get their own cabin housing assignment and report their mileage traveled. Registration will be followed by a delicious banquet supper in our Cafeteria and recreation in our state-of-the-art Fitness Center! Visiting students will check into their respective dorms after the evening variety show, so leave all luggage in the car until later in the evening. Many more fun activities are scheduled Monday morning, with all events officially finished at approximately 2pm Monday.

PARENTS/ADULT SPONSORS & WHAT TO BRING: GLAA requires a parent or adult sponsor accompany all visiting student(s) to campus to aid with additional supervision and/or emergency needs that we hope are not necessary. Parents/Sponsors vehicle mileage, lodging in one of the campmeeting cabins adjacent to our campus, and meals are all covered by the academy and free of charge. For adults/sponsors that would like this housing, please note that you **MUST** sign-up for a room when you sign up your student(s) on the form (link) entitled "Academy Days Registration Form". If additional family members are accompanying you, be sure to let us know that too. There is a \$20 key deposit for a cabin key, which is refunded when the key is returned on Monday afternoon. Each cabin has a queen-sized bed and a set of bunkbeds. Please bring your own bedding, pillows, towels, etc. (Note, pets are not allowed in the cabins.) Those wishing to stay in the local hotel, we recommend "Maxfields Inn" in Edmore at (989) 427-8888. Please be sure to inform us on the registration form of contact information (*location and cell number*), so we can reach you in case of emergency.

WHAT SHOULD STUDENTS BRING: Visiting students are asked to bring a sleeping bag, pillow, towel, personal items and toiletries along with a **positive, get-involved and have-fun attitude!** We request that all electronic equipment and cell phones be left at home or in vehicles, as any distraction could result in missed opportunities to make new friends or information not heard regarding a future with us.
