Registration is on Sunday (22nd) from 1:00 - 2:30pm. Following registration, we will have activities planned until approximately 2pm on Monday, April 23. We would strongly encourage you to bring your students, as this is the best time within the school year for them to have a "feel" of what it is like to be at GLAA, and it will also keep them excited about continuing their education at a Christian school.

Since we have a lot of visitors on these two days, it is necessary for us to make good plans. Attached is a form we ask you to fill out indicating how many students will be coming and what gender they are. Also, space is provided to inform us of school supervisors or parents bringing the students and if they will need housing for Sunday night. (If a supervisor is bringing additional family members, be sure to let us know, so we can provide the necessary housing.) We also request that every student bring a sleeping bag, as they will be staying on campus over night. All meals will be provided to students and their supervisors/parents.

We would appreciate receiving the enclosed form back as soon as possible. Please remember to include the name of a supervisor that will be attending with your group. It presents us with a problem when schools and churches drop off students and leave them with us unsupervised. **Therefore, a name(s) of a supervisor(s) MUST be enclosed and is very important!**
